#### Words from Rev Geoff Reading the Signs of our Time

Three years ago, I had an interesting conversation with Bill, one of Wollongong's more interesting characters in that he used to walk around the city with a bible verse written on cardboard attached to the front of his walker. On that day Bill was astride his new electric scooter which had been modified to accommodate a placard challenging people to wake up and read the signs of the times. After we had exchanged greetings, Bill said to me, "what do you reckon about all that is going on in the world now? Do you think that we are getting very close to seeing Jesus, the Son of Man coming in clouds with power and great glory?

Maybe, I replied. "There is a lot of scary stuff going on in our world now what with speculation of a future war with China, the uncertainty generated by the pandemic and the predictions that we are not going to prevent the planet from continuing to heat up. Yes, I can see how events such as these sit comfortably as the fulfilment of apocalyptic passages such as the one set down for this Sunday Luke 21: 25-36.

Three years on there is still a lot of scary stuff going on in the world. However, the focus or our fears has shifted from COVID 19 to the housing and cost of living crisis, new wars have broken out in the Middle East and in Europe, and we are experience extreme weather events.

It's not by accident that the Church begins the new liturgical year with some of the scary apocalyptic passages in the bible. For it is when we are scared, and anxious about the future that we are most open to being rescued from that which scares us. Now I am not suggesting that we should try and scare people into becoming a disciple of Jesus. However, perhaps we only realise we need a saviour when we are faced with situations which are beyond our capacity to control.

The Good news is that it is not our job to save the world because Jesus has promised to save the world. It is our job to offer that hope as an alternative to the fear that so corrodes the world and to point to the signs of his coming.


